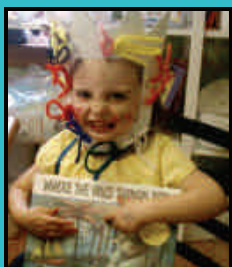


## LET'S GOGH ART-Western MA/CT STORYART CLASSES FOR AGES 3-6

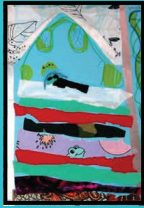

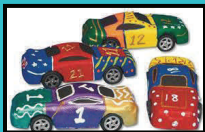

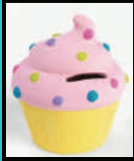

## StoryArt Class Features and Requirements

**Fee:** \$7 to \$9 per child

- One talented and inspiring instructor is provided for 45-60 minutes (*can provide more for an additional fee.*)
- Require the help of regular classroom teachers
- Held on weekday mornings (*may be able to provide at other times for a modest additional fee.*)
- All art materials and supplies, table cloths, cover ups for kids provided
- Minimum 20 children
- Discounts available for very large or multiple classes
- Modest travel fee applies if over 20 miles from our location
